

MINOR IN PSYCHOLOGY



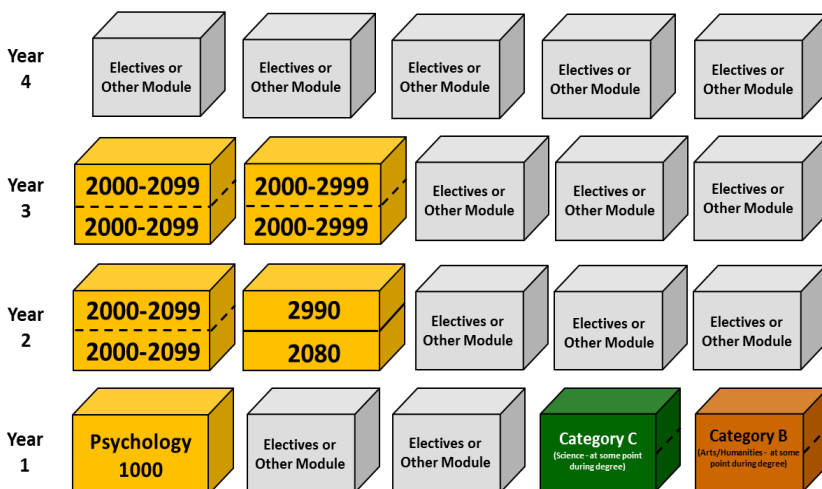
Purpose of Minor Module: To provide a grounding in the principles of Psychology for students who are interested in a career in such applied fields as business, education, law, the health sciences, social work, and other related disciplines. This program is not suitable for students who intend to pursue postgraduate work in Psychology.



Admission Requirements: To be eligible for admission to the Psychology Minor Program, students must complete a minimum of 3.0 first-year courses, including 1.0 course from Psychology 1000 with a final grade of at least 60%.

A student may combine a Psychology Minor with a Major, a Specialization or an Honours Specialization from another discipline for a 4 Year Degree. The Psychology Minor may also be combined with a Minor in a different discipline for a 3 Year Degree.

Psychology Minor Requirements:

- 1.0 credits Psychology 1000
- 1.0 credits Psychology 2080A/B, Psychology 2990A/B
- 2.0 credits in Psychology numbered 2000-2099
- 1.0 credits in Psychology numbered 2000-2999

- = 1 full course (1.0 credits) or 2 half courses (0.5 credit each)
- = Psychology Courses, Category A – Social Sciences
- = Category B – Arts/Humanities
- = Category C – Science
- = Electives or Other Module
