Abstract:

I will describe ability assessments based on WICS--wisdom, intelligence, and creativity, synthesized. I will discuss how we assess abilities, results from testing close to 20,000 individuals, and what these results mean for the future of assessments. It is time to move beyond narrow conceptions of abilities to much broader ones that consider the whole person rather than just a narrow sliver of that person.
