Clinical Practica Milestones: *The first clinical practicum is in Psychology 9901. This required initial assessment practicum is a year-long course that is weighted 1.0. After completing the initial assessment practica (Psych 9901), the practica milestones may include differing amounts of training in assessment and intervention. Thus, to ensure sufficient training in both assessment and intervention, each student is required to meet formally with the Clinical Practicum Co-ordinator at least once per year, to receive guidance in practica selection. At this meeting, all aspects of the student's clinical practica training will be reviewed, considering both breadth and depth of training, after which a formal practica training plan will be put in place for the upcoming year. This meeting will typically occur in February or March of each year.*

Note: The individual differences criteria can sometimes be met with a graduate course in psychopathology; however, the College of Psychologists of Ontario will not allow you to double count course credits (e.g., if you are counting psychopathology as meeting the requirement for communication of a diagnosis, then it cannot be counted as meeting individual differences). Given that the psychopathology course is now two separate required courses, you could count one as meeting the need for communication of a diagnosis and the other as covering off individual differences. If, however, you are intending to claim both child and adult competencies, you would need both to cover off diagnosis and have another course to cover off individual differences.
